Commission - White Night Brighton What will you do in the middle of the night, Brighton & Hove city council

This commission is running along side the White Night - Nuit Blanche commission, and is only for Brighton & Hove and not Amiens (FR).

White Night Brighton & Hove is seeking to commission 3 outdoor events for this year's festival:

- A centrepiece for the festival for Jubilee Square, which must be interactive and highly visible as it sits at the heart of White Night. It must be strongly linked to the theme Illumination. The budget is £3000
- Two smaller pieces, again themed on illumination, that respond to specific sites in the city. The budget for each of these is £1000

The new piece must be designed to take place outdoors and at night. It could be a sound art piece, a projection, an illumination, a performance or a 'happening' but must have visual impact. The piece must be sensitive to local residents particularly in terms of noise volume and duration. The piece must involve a Brighton and Hove based artist or creative professional although they may be collaborating with others from outside the city or the UK. The artist or a member of the creative team must have a track record of producing work in the public realm.
